***The Scottish Individual
Girls Chess Championships***

Is open to all girls playing chess in Scotland. It shall consist of a 5 round Swiss event, with all players playing in every round. There shall be 3 sections, which may be combined depending on numbers, and shall consist of;

P5 and Under, P6/7 and Secondary.

Prizes shall be awarded to the highest scoring players in each category for 1st, 2nd and 3rd. The winner of each category shall receive the championship shield to keep for one year. In the case of a tie, an appropriate method shall be used to work out placements for trophies however titles shall be shared.

Time control: 30 minutes per player, per game clocks shall be used on all boards

Rules: All normal rules of chess shall apply and these shall be explained on the day.

Entry fee: £6 per player

Timings: Please aim to arrive from 10.30 as this will

allow for registration and a prompt start time of 11 am. We expect the last round to conclude around 4.45pm with prize giving following shortly.

Café: There is no onsite café though we shall provide tea/coffee/juice. Please bring a packed lunch.

Parking: here is free parking on-site

The Scottish Girls Team Championships

In recent years has been combined with the individual championships because of financial difficulties to run 2 separate events.

The team categories are: Primary / Secondary

We now use the format of having as many girls in a team as each club/school desires to encourage as many girls to participate as possible. Each player plays in the individual tournament and is registered to a team with the highest 4 scores of that team totaled for the overall team score. Please note only the top 4 scores will receive a team prize!

For individual players attending we often make up teams on the day so everyone is involved and meets new people!

Prizes shall be awarded for the top 4 players in team which come 1st, 2nd and 3rd at **Primary level**. With 1st and 2nd placing being awarded for **Secondary teams**. In addition the champions shall also be awarded a shield/cup to be held for one year!
